

A Motivational Training Workshop to Help You Get the Most Out of Your Dog

I have been training dogs for over 45 years. Besides working with students owning a wide variety of breeds over the years, many who achieved OTCHs including Bearded Collies, Corgis, and Irish Setters to name a few, my personal dogs have included several terriers, golden retrievers, and border collies. I have been involved in a number of performance sports and have numerous advanced titles in obedience, rally, tracking, agility, herding, dock diving and field. I even put championships on two of my performance dogs—a golden and a border terrier. My border terrier was the first CH UDX of the breed and finished her TDX when she was 12 years old. My main passion has always been obedience. I have multiple titles at all levels with a variety of breeds, including 10 OTCHs—4 golden retrievers and 6 border collies. Over the years, I have shared my training methods with a variety of groups across the country—California, Oregon, Washington, Idaho, Colorado, South Dakota, Missouri, South Carolina, Maryland, North Carolina, and Florida.

I credit my successes with a wide variety of dogs on my basic training philosophy:

- **ATTITUDE IS EVERYTHING!** The most important thing to me is building the "right" training relationship by building the the dog's "want to" attitude BEFORE adding the "have to". It is also important to me to keep the dog's positive attitude throughout their long show career by keeping training sessions fun.
- **ERROR-FREE TRAINING:** I create the finished dog by building on success, not failure, and the effective use of praise, rewards, and positive proofing to build confidence and consistency.
- BALANCED, REWARDS-BASED TRAINING: I have control of the rewards and use them correctly to train and motivate to get the most out of my dog.
- FOCUS ON FUNDAMENTALS: I continue to focus on the foundational skills that make up the exercises
 throughout my dog's show career. My Back to FUNdamentals Workshop is geared to every level of
 trainer/dog teams.
